New award helps upgrading students transition to higher education

VICTORIA – The BC Scholarship Society, supported through initial funding from the provincial government, has provided 45 Transition Awards worth \$5,000 each to support students progressing from Adult Basic Education (ABE) into full-time post-secondary studies.

"This Transition Award has helped me pursue my dream to become a dental hygienist. The funds from the Award have been put away for expensive equipment and books that are difficult to afford. Thanks again to the BC Scholarship Society - an amazing organization. If I could tell everyone to apply for this award, I would" said Transition Award Recipient Abby Boutin.

It's anticipated that there will be one million new job openings in B.C. over the next 10 years, and that 80% of them will require post-secondary education or skills training. The BC Scholarship Society is helping more people cross the bridge into full-time higher education.

"We are focused on improving access and affordability so that more people can get the training and education they need to reach their full potential," said Selina Robinson, Minister of Post-Secondary Education and Future Skills. "The BC Scholarship Society's Transition Awards open the door for students to pursue their education full-time, helping them begin their new careers sooner."

Since 2006, the <u>BC Scholarship Society</u> has awarded over \$30 million to thousands of B.C. students through five different programs including Transfer, ABE Transition, International, Indigenous and Women in Technology. The society is administered by the Victoria Foundation.

"This is a new award category for us," explains Melvin Berg, the chair of the Society. "It adds another support for those who have been upgrading their education or acquiring the pre-requisites to enter full-time university or college studies. Many of these students are upskilling or undertaking a change in their career paths," says Berg.
