# **IKE BARBER TRANSFER SCHOLARSHIP**

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS (FAQ)



## I am transferring to a new program that is in a different field than my current program. Can I apply?

No, the Scholarship is intended for students who are transferring in order to complete their current program. Students who are transferring to start a new program in a different field are not eligible for this Scholarship.

### I haven't yet completed the minimum 21 transferable post-secondary credits. Can I apply?

Yes, you can apply as long as you will complete the minimum 21 transferable post-secondary credits prior to transferring to your new institution. If this is the case, you must submit an updated transcript once you have completed the required number of credits.

## I'm a part-time student. Can I apply?

No, you must be a full-time student (as defined by your institution) in order to be eligible for the Scholarship.

However, if you have been granted a medical or disability exemption from full-time course load by your institution, you can apply (documentation may be required).

#### I attend and/or am transferring to a private post-secondary institution. Can I apply?

No, you must be enrolled at AND be transferring to a BC public post-secondary institution.

On the application form, you will be asked to select your current and future institutions from a list. If either of the institutions are not on this list, you are not eligible for the Scholarship.

#### Who should I list as my reference?

Your reference should be someone who can comment on your character, accomplishments, and any challenges you have faced. It is best to not have this person be a friend or member of your family. A professor, coach, or volunteer supervisor would all be good references.

When you apply online, you will be asked to provide the name and contact information for your chosen reference. Your reference will receive an email invitation to complete a reference form online. We do not accept references in any other format (written letter, email, etc.). You will be notified when your reference has completed their form, but you will not be able to view the contents.

Note that you will not be able to submit your complete application without a completed reference form.
